Miko the Fox

MATERIALS

Rainbow Cotton 8/4

2 skeins of color Rust (101)
1 skein of color Light Grey (016)
1 skein of color White (001)

Easy Care Classic

1 skein of color Light Gray - Mix (252)

Crochet hook 2.5 mm and 4.5 mm
A small piece of black scrap yarn
2 safety eyes 5 mm
Stuffing

YARN QUALITY

 **Rainbow Cotton 8/4**, Hobbii
100% cotton / 50 g (1.75 oz) = 170 meters (186 yds)

 **Easy Care Classic**, Mayflower
100% Merino Wool
50 g (1.8 oz) = Ca. 106 m (116 yds)

ABBREVIATIONS

ch = chain
sc = single crochet
sl st = slip stitch
mr = magic ring
blo = back loop only
inc = increase - 2 stitches in the same stitch
dec = decrease - 2 stitches together
rnd = round(s)
(xx) = Number of stitches after ended round

Miko the Fox is a cute fox crocheted in Rainbow Cotton 8/4. Parts of the pattern have photo references, so it is easy to make.

INFO AND TIPS

Always stuff the head and body firmly.

Always stuff between head and body as you sew the head on to avoid a wobbly head.

Work tightly to avoid holes between the stitches.

All pieces are worked in the round except for the scarf.

Body

With crochet hook 2.50 mm and in Rust.

Rnd 1: 6 sc in a mr

Rnd 2: (inc) 6 times (12)

Rnd 3: (1 sc, inc) 6 times (18)

Rnd 4: (2 sc, inc) 6 times (24)

Rnd 5: (3 sc, inc) 6 times (30)

Rnd 6: (4 sc, inc) 6 times (36)

Rnd 7: (5 sc, inc) 6 times (42)

Rnd 8: (6 sc, inc) 6 times (48)

Rnd 9: (7 sc, inc) 6 times (54)

Rnd 10: (8 sc, inc) 6 times (60)

Rnd 11: (9 sc, inc) 6 times (66)

Rnd 12-19: 1 sc in each st (66)

Rnd 20: (9 sc, dec) 6 times (60)

Rnds 21-23: 1 sc in each st (60)

Rnd 24: (8 sc, dec) 6 times (54)

Rnds 25-27: 1 sc in each st (54)

Rnd 28: (7 sc, dec) 6 times (48)

Rnds 29-31: 1 sc in each st (48)

Rnd 32: (6 sc, dec) 6 times (42)

Rnds 33-35: 1 sc in each st (42)

Rnd 36: (5 sc, dec) 6 times (36)

Stuff the body as you work.

Rnds 37-39: 1 sc in each st (36)

Rnd 40: (4 sc, dec) 6 times (30)

Rnds 41-43: 1 sc in each st (30)

Rnd 44: (3 sc, dec) 6 times (24)
Rnds 45-46: 1 sc in each st (24)
Rnd 47: (2 sc, dec) 6 times (18)
Rnd 48: 1 sc in each st (18)
Fasten off.

Tail

With crochet hook 2.50 mm and in White.

Rnd 1: 3 sc in a mr
Rnd 2: (inc) 3 times (6)
Rnd 3: (1 sc, inc) 3 times (9)
Rnd 4: 1 sc in each st (9)
Rnd 5: (2 sc, inc) 3 times (12)
Rnd 6: 1 sc in each st (12)
Rnd 7: (3 sc, inc) 3 times (15)
Rnd 8: 1 sc in each st (15)
Rnd 9: (4 sc, inc) 3 times (18)
Rnd 10: 1 sc in each st (18)
Rnd 11: (5 sc, inc) 3 times (21)
Rnd 12: 1 sc in each st (21)
Rnd 13: (6 sc, inc) 3 times (24)
Rnd 14: 1 sc in each st (24)

Change to Rust.

Rnd 15: 1 sc in each st (24)
Rnd 16: (3 sc, inc) 6 times (30)
Rnd 17: (4 sc, inc) 6 times (36)
Rnds 18-24: 1 sc in each st (36)
Rnd 25: (4 sc, dec) 6 times (30)
Rnd 26: 1 sc in each st (30)
Rnd 27: (3 sc, dec) 6 times (24)
Rnds 28-29: 1 sc in each st (24)
Rnd 30: (2 sc, dec) 6 times (18)
Rnds 31-33: 1 sc in each st (18)

Remember to stuff the tail lightly as you work.

Rnd 34: (4 sc, dec) 3 times (15)
Rnd 35: 1 sc in each st (15)
Rnd 36: (3 sc, dec) 3 times (12)
Rnd 37: 1 sc in each st (12)
Rnd 38: (2 sc, dec) 3 times (9)
Rnds 39-40: 1 sc in each st (9)
Rnd 41: (1 sc, dec) 3 times (6)

Fasten off and leave a tail long enough for sewing.

Use a needle to gather the last 6 stitches in the front loop and tighten the yarn to close the hole nicely.

Head

With crochet hook 2.50 mm and in White.

Here we will work around the foundation chain.

Rnd 1: Ch 25, begin the next round in the first ch

Rnd 2: inc, 22 sc, (inc) 2 times, 22 sc, inc (52)

Rnd 3: inc, 24 sc, (inc) 2 times, 24 sc, inc (56)

Rnd 4: inc, 2 sc, inc, 24 sc, inc, 2 sc, inc, 24 sc (60)

Rnd 5: inc, 3 sc, inc, 25 sc, inc, 3 sc, inc, 25 sc (64)

Rnds 6-16: 1 sc in each st (64)



Now you are going to make the decreases. It is important to follow the pattern instructions carefully to make the head shape look like a triangle.

Rnd 17: (dec) 3 times, 26 sc, (dec) 3 times, 26 sc (58)

Rnd 18: (dec) 2 times, 25 sc, (dec) 2 times, 25 sc (54)

Rnd 19: (dec) 2 times, 23 sc, (dec) 2 times, 23 sc (50)

Rnd 20: (dec) 2 times, 21 sc, (dec) 2 times, 21 sc (46)

Rnd 21: (dec) 2 times, 19 sc, (dec) 2 times, 19 sc (42)

Attach the eyes between rounds 13-14 with 11 sc in between.

Stuff the head as you work.

Rnd 22: (5 sc, dec) 6 times (36)

Rnd 23: (4 sc, dec) 6 times (30)

Rnd 24: (3 sc, dec) 6 times (24)

Rnd 25: (2 sc, dec) 6 times (18)

Fasten off and leave a tail long enough for sewing.

Hood

With crochet hook 2.50 mm and in Rust.

Here we will work around the foundation chain.

Rnd 1: Ch 25, begin the next round in the first ch

Rnd 2: inc, 22 sc, (inc) 2 times, 22 sc, inc (52)

Rnd 3: inc, 24 sc, (inc) 2 times, 24 sc, inc (56)
 Rnd 4: inc, 2 sc, inc, 24 sc, inc, 2 sc, inc, 24 sc (60)
 Rnd 5: inc, 3 sc, inc, 25 sc, inc, 3 sc, inc, 25 sc (64)
 Rnds 6-12: 1 sc in each st (64)
 Rnd 13: 6 sc, 1 sl st (to end at the side of the hood)

Fasten off and leave a tail long enough for sewing.

Nose bridge

With crochet hook 2.50 mm and in Rust.

The top of the hood must point towards yourself.
 Turn the work after each ended round.

Rnd 1: Now, count 12 sc to the left from the slip stitch of the previous round, insert the yarn in the 13th sc. It is important to center the nose bridge on the head in relation to the increases.
 Crochet the first sc in the same stitch and then another 6 sc, ch 1, turn (7)
 Rnd 2: Skip the first st, 6 sc, ch 1, turn
 Rnd 3: Skip the first st, 5 sc, ch 1, turn
 Rnd 4: Skip the first st, 4 sc, ch 1, turn
 Rnd 5: Skip the first st, 3 sc, ch 1, turn
 Rnd 6: Skip the first st, 2 sc, ch 1, turn
 Rnds 7-11: 2 sc, ch 1, turn
 Rnd 12: Work a row of sc around the entire hood.



Nose

With crochet hook 2.50 mm and in White.

Rnd 1: 6 sc in a mr
 Rnd 2: (1 sc, inc) 3 times (9)
 Rnds 3-4: 1 sc in each st, 1 sl st (9)

Fasten off and leave a tail long enough for sewing.

Ear

With crochet hook 2.50 mm and in Light Grey, make 2

Rnd 1: 3 sc in a mr

Rnd 2: (inc) 3 times (6)

Rnd 3: (1 sc, inc) 3 times (9)

Rnd 4: (2 sc, inc) 3 times (12)

Rnd 5: (3 sc, inc) 3 times (15)

Change to Rust.

Rnd 6: (4 sc, inc) 3 times (18)

Rnd 7: (5 sc, inc) 3 times (21)

Rnds 8-11: 1 sc in each st (21)

Rnd 12: (5 sc, dec) 3 times (18)

Fasten off and leave a tail long enough for sewing.

Leg

With crochet hook 2.50 mm and in Light Grey, make 2

Rnd 1: 6 sc in a mr

Rnd 2: (inc) 6 times (12)

Rnd 3: (1 sc, inc) 6 times (18)

Rnd 4: (2 sc, inc) 6 times (24)

Rnd 5: (3 sc, inc) 6 times (30)

Rnds 6-7: 1 sc in each st (30)

Change to Rust.

Rnds 8-9: 1 sc in each st (30)

Rnd 10: (3 sc, dec) 6 times (24)

Rnd 11: 1 sc in each st (24)

Rnd 12: (2 sc, dec) 6 times (18)

Rnd 13: 1 sc in each st (18)

Rnd 14: (4 sc, dec) 3 times (15)

Rnds 15-44: 1 sc in each st (15)

Fasten off and leave a tail long enough for sewing.

Arm

With crochet hook 2.50 mm and in Light Grey, make 2

Rnd 1: 6 sc in a mr

Rnd 2: (inc) 6 times (12)

Rnd 3: (3 sc, inc) 3 times (15)

Rnds 4-5: 1 sc in each st (15)

Change to Rust.

Stuff the arm lightly as you work if you wish.

Rnds 6-35: 1 sc in each st (15)

Fasten off and leave a tail long enough for sewing.

Scarf

With crochet hook 4.5 mm and Easy Care Classic in Light Gray

Crochet very loosely.

Ch 1 to turn the work after each ended row and work in the back loop only.

Ch 5

Rnd 1: 4 sc in blo, ch 1, turn

Repeat row 1 until the scarf measures approx. 50 cm (19.6 inches).

Now, cut 16 strands each measuring 15 cm (5.9 inches) for fringes. Take two strands and fold them double. Use the hook to pull the strands through the scarf. Insert the ends into the loop and tighten to "lock" them. Repeat until you have 4 fringes at each end of the scarf. Cut the fringes to the desired length.





Assembling

- Sew on the nose on rounds 16-18 in the middle of the face.
- Sew the hood onto the head and nose.
- Embroider eyebrows and snout on the head as shown in the picture.
- Sew the ears onto the two "corners" of the head.
- Attach the head to the body by sewing the 18 single crochets of the head together with the 18 single crochets of the body. Stuff some extra stuffing into the neck before closing completely to avoid a wobbly head.
- Stuff a bit of stuffing into the arms but be careful not to stuff them all the way up to the edge. Sew the arms onto the body on round 45.
- Put stuffing into the legs but be careful not to stuff them all the way up to the edge. Sew the legs onto the body on round 4.
- Sew on the tail in the middle of the backside where you prefer.

Put the scarf on Miko and he is finished!
